



## Fall 2024 Rules

### COED and Men's 11 v 11

#### New additions:

- Rosters-To be eligible for Playoffs/Championship games, players must be on the team roster by game 5.
  - One-off cases can be brought to the board for approval
    - Example- female gets hurt and numbers of females are low- board could allow an exception.
- Penalty kicks
  - Rotate through the 11 players on the field when game ended
  - Rotate male, female, male, female, male
  - Next rotation- pick from the remaining 11 on the field who have yet to take a kick (females may need to repeat if only 3 on field when game ended)
  - Goalies are part of the rotation
- Weather/game stoppage
  - If under 30 min into game, Board will attempt to reschedule
  - After halftime, games stand at current result
- Adult coed must always play with both genders on the field. Minimum of 3 field players from each gender must be on the field. (No position restrictions)
  - If not enough females, teams will play down a player for each female not on field.
- Roster size- max 22 (Must be **a registered paid player**)
- Field Marshal will be at each game wearing a tie-dye shirt
  - They will check player cards, shin guards, rosters.
  - They will be the contact person during games.
  - No player should confront the Referee. The Field Marshal will step in if needed.

- Games will start at the specified game time- clock will start
- A player subbing for multiple divisions must be registered as a dual player!
  - Example- If a player wants to sub for a coed team, they must be a registered player in the coed division and/or a dual registrant. A men's or women's division player who is only registered in the single division is not eligible to sub for a coed team.
  - It is courtesy to let the other captain know if you are using a sub. If your team has a full bench, there is no need to use a sub from another team.
- FIFA Laws of the game will be used accordingly except for:
  - No slide tackling
- Games will be played with 2 45 min halves.
- Playoffs and Championships- Teams can only use their rostered players from time of registration. No subs allowed.
- Must adhere to Code of Conduct within bylaws
  - RSL has a discipline committee. This committee will tackle all behaviors according to the bylaws. Behavior we **WILL NOT** tolerate (from players or bystanders):
    - Fighting
    - Getting in the face of a referee in a derogatory manner
    - Cussing a referee
    - Blatant physical play with intention of harming another player
    - Derogatory comments made towards other players

## **Women's 9 v 9**

- Field Marshal will be at each game wearing a tie-dye shirt
  - They will check player cards, shin guards, rosters.
  - They will be the contact person during games.
  - No player should confront the Referee. The Field Marshal will step in if needed.
- Games will start at the specified game time- clock will start
- A player subbing for multiple divisions must be registered as a dual player!
  - Example- If a player wants to sub for a coed team, they must be a registered player in the coed division and/or a dual registrant. A men's or women's division player who is only registered in the single division is not eligible to sub for a coed team.
  - It is courtesy to let the other captain know if you are using a sub. If your team has a full bench, there is no need to use a sub from another team.
- FIFA Laws of the game will be used accordingly except for:
  - No slide tackling
  - Subbing- on the fly versus referee call in
- Games will be played with 2 -28 min halves. (short half time – 4 min)

- Playoffs and Championships- Teams can only use their rostered players from time of registration. No subs allowed.
- Must adhere to Code of Conduct within bylaws
  - RSL has a discipline committee. This committee will tackle all behaviors according to the bylaws. Behavior we **WILL NOT** tolerate (from players or bystanders):
    - Fighting
    - Getting in the face of a referee in a derogatory manner
    - Cussing a referee
    - Blatant physical play with intention of harming another player
    - Derogatory comments made towards other players
